

AIPEA Fellows

The AIPEA Fellows program was established at the AIPEA Council meeting at the 2003 Euroclay Conference in Modena, Italy.

- 1) AIPEA Fellowship was established to recognize and reward clay scientists with a *life-long activity* in promoting clay science and in supporting the clay science community through AIPEA or other bodies;
2. A proposal may be submitted by a member of Council, by a liaison officer, by a national or regional society of clay scientists;
3. The proposal may contain publications, documents (e.g., CV) and letters of support. It shall be submitted electronically to the President of AIPEA by January 1 of the year of the International Clay Conference.
4. The selection of the candidates is made by the entire Council based on the materials contained in the proposal(s).
5. Fellows must be members of AIPEA. The successful awardee will be invited to take part in the International Clay Conference, and AIPEA will pay for the registration fee.
6. A maximum of two fellows can be selected at each International Clay Conference.
